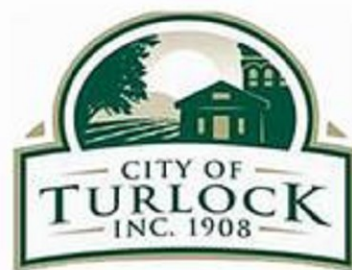

1. Your September 2025 City of Turlock Utility Bill (TID, PG&E or cell phone bill are NOT accepted)
2. Your picture ID with a Turlock address

PLEASE NOTE:

1. No more than one load per current utility bill
2. No vehicle load larger than a pick-up truck
3. No more than 9 tires per load
4. No sealed gas cylinders (propane, oxygen, etc.)
5. No treated wood

Reminder:

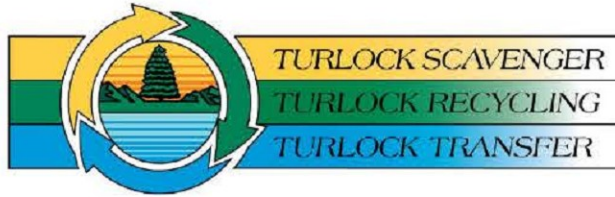
Stanislaus County will be having their **HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE** at 901 S. Walnut Rd from 8 AM to 12 PM for **FREE** HHW disposal.

- Antifreeze
- Car batteries
- Brake fluid
- Used oil/oil filters
- Paint/paint thinners
- Pesticides
- Fertilizers
- Pool/spa chemicals
- Drain cleaners
- Batteries (limit 1qt)

Sharps must be stored in a rigid container with a closed lid/leak proof. Examples: coffee cans and empty soda bottles.

Button batteries must be taped. Load limit is 15 gallons (125lbs) no containers larger than 5 gallons.

- Anticongelante
- Baterías de automóvil
- líquido de frenos
- Aceite usado / filtros de aceite
- Pintura / diluyentes de pintura
- Pesticidas
- Fertilizantes
- Productos químicos para piscinas/spas
- Limpiadores de desagües
- Baterías (límite de 1 cuarto de galón)

Los objetos punzocortantes deben almacenarse en un recipiente rígido con tapa cerrada y a prueba de fugas.

Ejemplos: latas de café y botellas vacías de refresco.

Las baterías tipo botón deben estar envueltas con cinta adhesiva.

El límite de carga es de 15 galones (125 libras), no se aceptan recipientes de más de 5 galones.

LEAF PICK - UP PROGRAM

NOVEMBER 3, 2025 - FEBRUARY 6, 2026

The City of Turlock Municipal Services Maintenance Division will begin its annual Leaf Pickup Program on November 3, 2025. **Residents are strongly encouraged to use their green waste containers first for leaves.** If all leaves do not fit in the green container, they may be placed in loose piles on the street, 18 inches from the curb--**DO NOT USE BAGS.**

LEAF PICK-UP ROUTES

- Zone 1: Nov 3, Nov 13, Dec 1, Jan 8
- Zone 2: Nov 3, Nov 13, Dec 2, Jan 12
- Zone 3: Nov 4, Nov 17, Dec 4, Jan 13
- Zone 4: Nov 4, Nov 17, Dec 8, Jan 15
- Zone 5: Nov 5, Nov 18, Dec 9, Jan 20
- Zone 6: Nov 5, Nov 18, Dec 11, Jan 22
- Zone 7: Nov 6, Nov 19, Dec 15, Jan 26
- Zone 8: Nov 6, Nov 19, Dec 16, Jan 27
- Zone 9: Nov 10, Nov 20, Dec 18, Jan 29
- Zone 10: Nov 10, Nov 20, Dec 22, Feb 2
- Zone 11: Nov 12, Nov 24, Jan 5, Feb 3
- Zone 12: Nov 12, Nov 25, Jan 6, Feb 4

Tips for a Successful Leaf Pickup:

Leaves Only: Ensure your piles contain only leaves. Piles mixed with wood or branches will not be collected.

Parking: Avoid parking vehicles in front of your residence in a way that obstructs leaf collection. This includes the day before, the day of, and the day after your scheduled pickup.

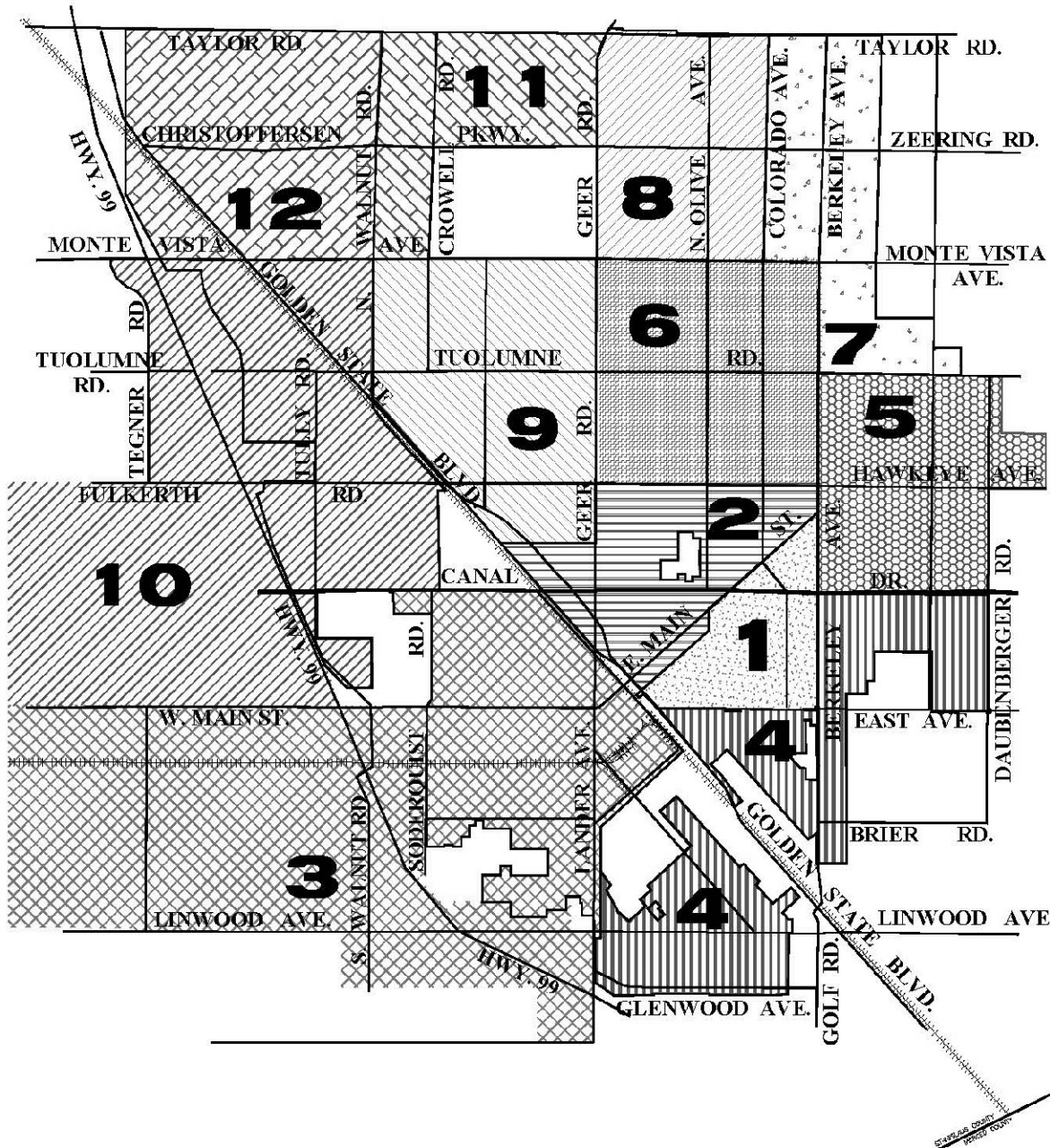
Trash Day: If your leaf pickup coincides with your trash collection day, keep your bins and leaf piles separate for easy access.

Gutters: Place your leaf piles 18 inches from the curb to help prevent street flooding during rain.

The City is divided into 12 zones for leaf collection, with Wednesdays and Fridays reserved for maintenance. Leaf collection will follow the scheduled days for each zone.

to attend a Public Information Meeting.

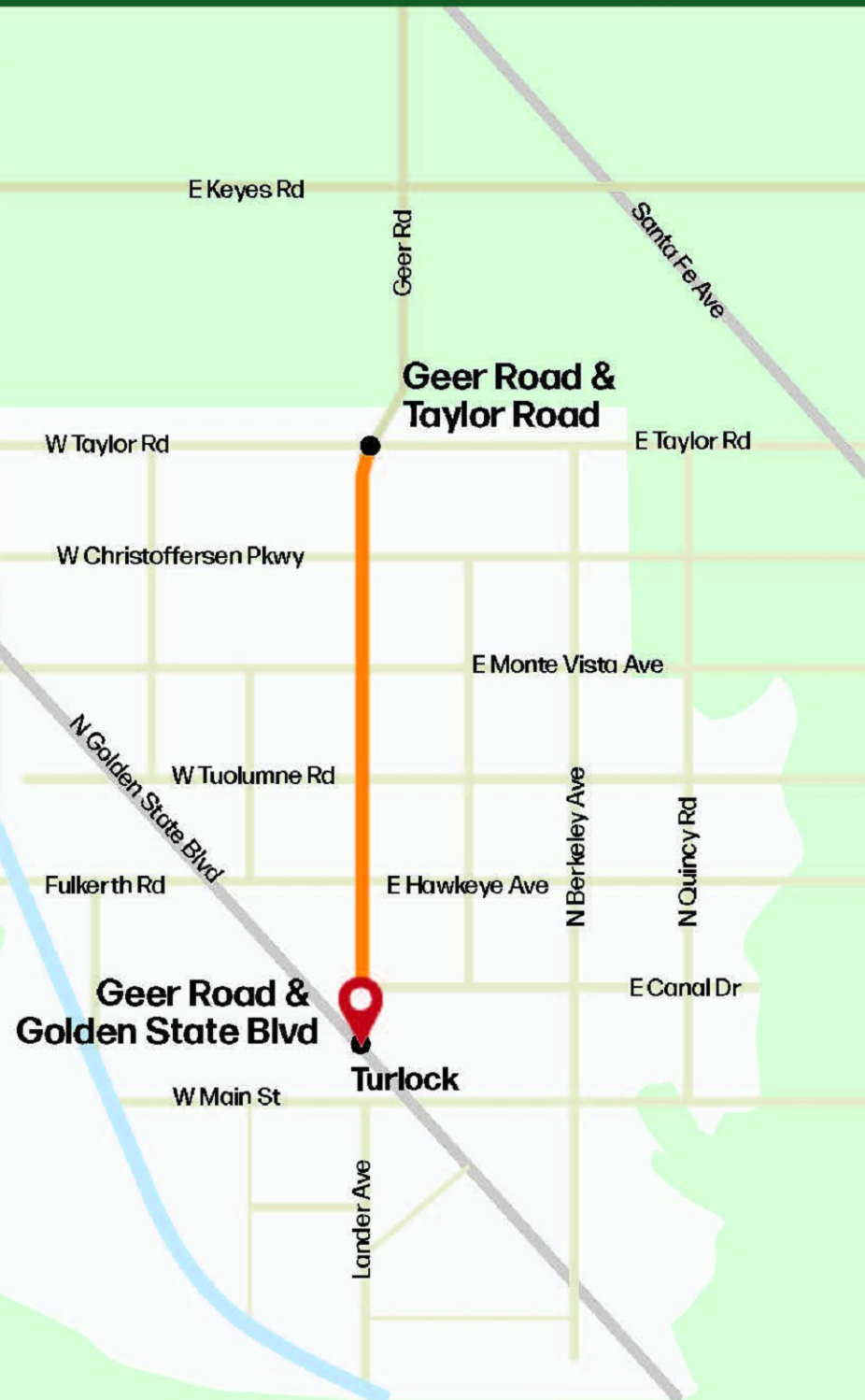
The City of Turlock is designing the rehabilitation of the Geer Road corridor between North Golden State Boulevard and Taylor Road.

This effort marks another milestone advanced under the **Turlock Roads Initiative Program**. The goal of this project is to improve the corridor consistent with the City's General Plan.

Upgrades to the Geer Road corridor include some or all of the following:

- pavement rehabilitation
- pedestrian facilities
- ADA curb ramps
- roadway restriping
- other potential improvements
